Our Main Agenda Items This Month:



Halting foreign meddling in Judea and Samaria: Halting foreign meddling in Judea and Samaria: Regavim's efforts to halt foreign funding for illegal PA activity had some important results this past month: Based on our research and analysis, the [EU Commission's budget](#) dispatch was suspended on the grounds that it provides massive funding for anti-Israel activity and illegal construction in Area C. In another important achievement, Israel's Minister of Defense designated Samidoun as a terrorist organization. Regavim was the first to identify the terrorist ties of this and other highly politicized PFLP-affiliated organizations. [Read more>>>](#)



Preparing for Israel's elections – and beyond: In preparation for the elections, and more importantly, in preparation for the formation of a new government, Regavim prepared position papers - on the battle for Area C, and on Bedouin resettlement in the Negev - which we presented to the various political parties. These concise papers served the candidates as they formulated their elections platforms, and will be important elements in coalition negotiations and the formulation of the coalition agreement that will shape the next government.



'The Silent Conquest': Regavim-Makor Rishon Conference: In conjunction with the Israeli newspaper Makor Rishon, we held a virtual conference on the issue of the silent conquest that is unfolding in Judea and Samaria. Ministers and MKs, public figures, journalists and activists involved in the battle for the open spaces of the heartland of Israel spoke about the PA's systematic takeover, the Europeans' support, links to BDS and more. Regavim helps the farmers of Nevatim return to their land: For far too long, the residents of Nevatim suffered vandalism, invasion and takeover of their land, and the threat of violence. Their lives had become a nightmare - and they turned to us for help. After we exerted unrelenting pressure on the responsible authorities, enforcement action was carried out; the Bedouin squatters were removed, the structures they had built on Nevatim's farmland were demolished, and the farmers of Nevatim were able to resume their lives and livelihoods. Freedom of Information Petition: Electricity connections in Judea and Samaria: We petitioned the Jerusalem District Court after the Civil Administration refused to provide data on the extent of electricity connections apparently provided to illegal Palestinian structures by the East Jerusalem Electric Co., an Israeli-licensed power supplier. Supreme judicial bias: For more than a decade, we've been defending the rights of Jewish landowners whose property has been overrun by Bedouin in the Negev. In conjunction with the rightful owners, Regavim appealed to the High Court of Justice to require the government to adhere to a specified timeframe for the eviction of the Bedouin who have built hundreds of illegal structures in the Bir Hadaj squatters' camp – the crime capital of the Negev. 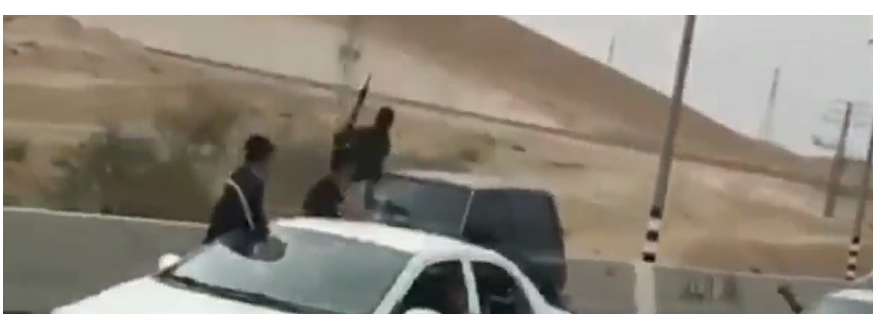

The Jewish National Fund (KKL-JNF) has begun to redeem land in Judea and Samaria: The Jewish National Fund, established in 1901 for the purpose of purchasing and redeeming land in the Land of Israel, recently announced a policy shift: For the first time, it will act directly to redeem land in Judea and Samaria.
